## **Treasurer's Report**

Thelma Cook, Treasurer gave the treasurers report. We currently have a balance of \$43.695.57. Expenses included two scholarships, speaker travel expenses, and a cake for the Master Gardener graduation in August.

## **OLD BUSINESS**

<u>AgCenter Remodel</u>: The remodel of the AgCenter is scheduled to being on October 13<sup>th</sup>. There is very little remaining of MG supplies that need to be moved. Mark Derise reported that some seeds are all that remains. It is estimated that the remodel will take at least 290 days (9 months), which takes us past the spring Expo. Mark reported that they have agreed to start on the greenhouse repair as soon as our Fall sale is complete. So we may have greenhouse available to plant for the spring Expo. Rob suggested that we use the walled in section of the greenhouse to start the seeds. No definite plan was established.

<u>Scholarship:</u> Linda Finley announced that she presented a check to Caleb Chaisson and he was very appreciative. She also contacted Haley Harley to let her know she was also a recipient and mailed the check to her. Both checks have been cashed.

School Gardens: Nola Ducote reported that she, Keith Greenlee, and Mark Derise met with Leslie Petross of the Calcasieu Parish School Board about our working with parish teachers. It was stressed that we need to contact the teacher to let them know that we are available to provide recommendations and guidance. Leslie will provide email and cell numbers of teachers interested in starting a school garden. There will be an in-service meeting on Oct. 2 with teachers and interested MG's may attend. The MG's need to send the check for the monies promised to the program to Leslie Petross. Some schools that are requesting help are Vinton HS and elementary, Westlake, Prien Lake Elementary and Iowa middle school. **4-H**: 4-H has moved their offices to the McNeese Farm. They will contact us when they need help with 4-H day.

Fall Plant Sale: Mark and Keith purchased 20 small Celeste and Brown Turkey fig trees and repotted them to larger pots to be sold at the Fall plant sale. If they do not sell, they will be saved to be sold at the spring Expo. The tentative date for the plant sale is the third weekend of October. Actual date depends on the growth of our plants.
