Treasurer's Report

<u>Mulch</u>: Keith Greenlee reported that a bale of pinestraw that covers about 10 sq. ft. will cost about \$10. A discussion was held, and members agreed that pinestraw is the best mulch material because it will last longer than bark mulch since it will not float away with the heavy rains.

4-H: Janet announced that there is nothing new to report from the 4-H group.

<u>Fall Plant Sale</u>: Mark reported that the good points of the sale included, 1) Advertisement, 2) MG help, 3) Clipboards away from greenhouse with MG there to answer questions, and 4) Rob as cashier. Some improvements include, 1) Laminate signs with names on both sides to be read from both directions, 2) arrange list in same order as plants in greenhouse to make location easier, 3) have water available for workers, and 4) help needed for cashier.
